

HOMWORK

- assigned on average 3 nights a week and should take about 5-10 minutes.
- is work you start in class and whatever you don't finish becomes your homework.
- should never have blanks or unanswered parts. You need to at least try to answer.

INFINITE CAMPUS & GRADES

- Your online grade program is called Infinite Campus (IC).
- There are 2 main parts to your science grade:
Work (assignments, labs, activities) and
Assessments (write ups, projects, quizzes, tests).

Work is about 50% of your grade and assessments are about 50%.

- Work **not turned in** is marked Missing and will receive a **zero** score (not good!) until you turn in the missing work. You need to learn the material **before** an assessment so you are allowed to go back and finish your missing work to turn in as late. Late work must be completely finished (not incomplete) and will only be accepted **before** an assessment. Study your work regularly to help prepare you for assessments.

You will participate in several labs and activities this year. You are expected to follow the district safety rules at all times.
